Salt Hands - Lambe Lambe

**a journey through the world of
miniature puppets to a tiny
stage where theatre unfolds in
a deeply individualized way**

SYNOPSIS

We take our inspiration from "lambe-lambe" theatre, which has a strong tradition in Brazil, and from "à la minute" cameras. These cameras were the true origin of the form; many of us still remember them as vintage photographic booths in public squares. There, the photographer would duck under a cloth to take and quickly develop the classic photo of children perched atop a wooden hobby horse.

The "lambe-lambe" style adapts this photographic ritual into a theatrical one: instead of a photo being developed inside the box, a miniature world comes to life for a single spectator peering through a viewfinder.

TEATRO E MARIONETAS DE MANDRÁGORA

Teatro e Marionetas de Mandrágora is a professional puppet theater company, founded on 2 April 2002, directed by **Clara Ribeiro** and **Filipa Mesquita** and **enVide neFelibata** as art direction.

■ In the symbiosis of a symbolic language that combines heritage and traditional legacy with the contemporary society's thinking and dynamics, in a dialogue that's not always peaceful, a fundamental element emerges: the puppet — the tool used in our quest for our own cultural identity.

■ Our goal is to discover the puppet's own aesthetic, visual, scenic, and dramatic potential, as well as in the relation between actor and puppet. In this experience, we intend to find our own identity-based dramaturgy: the one that explores culture, belief, and folklore combined with the urban area, the technological exploitation and the global village's fast pace.

■ Throughout our artistic journey, we created a wide range of proposals, both in terms of audiences (adults, youngsters schoolchildren, families) and in terms of training (basic and specialized).

■ One of our major commitments is touring our projects, through the country and abroad. We constantly concern on decentralization, community work, partnerships, social and inclusive enhancement.

■ For over two decades, the Company firmly established itself as a contemporary artistic creation structure by putting on a wide range of shows. Some creations our own, others resulted from partnerships with national and foreign cultural structures and entities.

■ Our team has always had space to freely create according to each other's

language and vision, converging to develop and enrich the puppet theater's art.

■ Our Company focuses on social vulnerabilities but also traditions and heritage through different but converging sights. Dialogue with all different audiences, blend our creations with sites and spaces, intersect with partner entities and structures is essential for creating multidisciplinary projects that prioritize communication with spectators.

■ We would like to highlight our collaboration with numerous educational service teams while implementing our education activities program in institutions such as monuments, museums, and landmark buildings.

■ *Teatro e Marionetas de Mandrágora is supported by Portuguese Republic – Culture, Youth, and Sports / Directorate-General for the Arts, Espinho Municipality / Espinho City Council, and Gondomar Municipality. The structure is based at FACE - Espinho Art and Culture Forum and headquartered in Gondomar.*

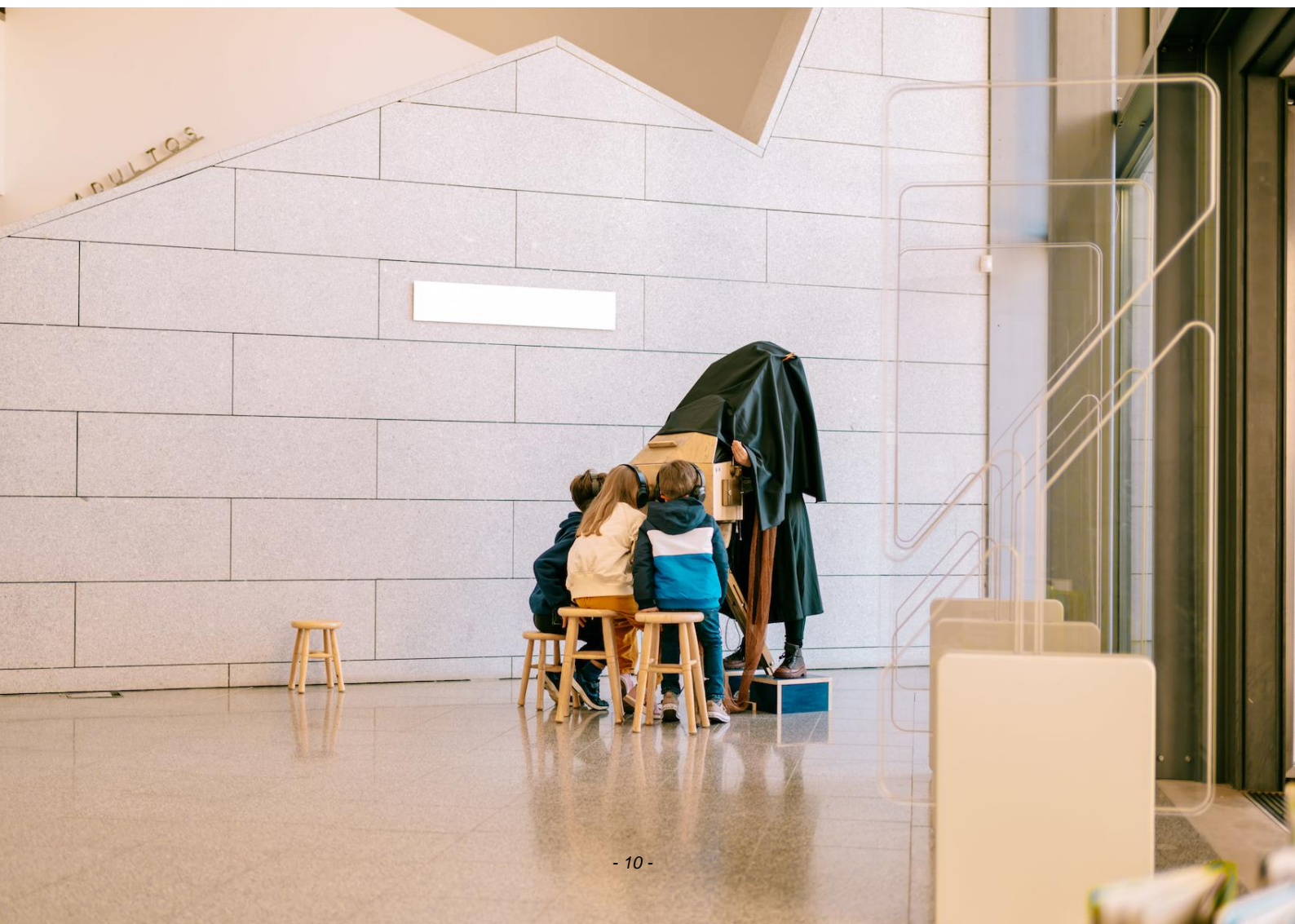

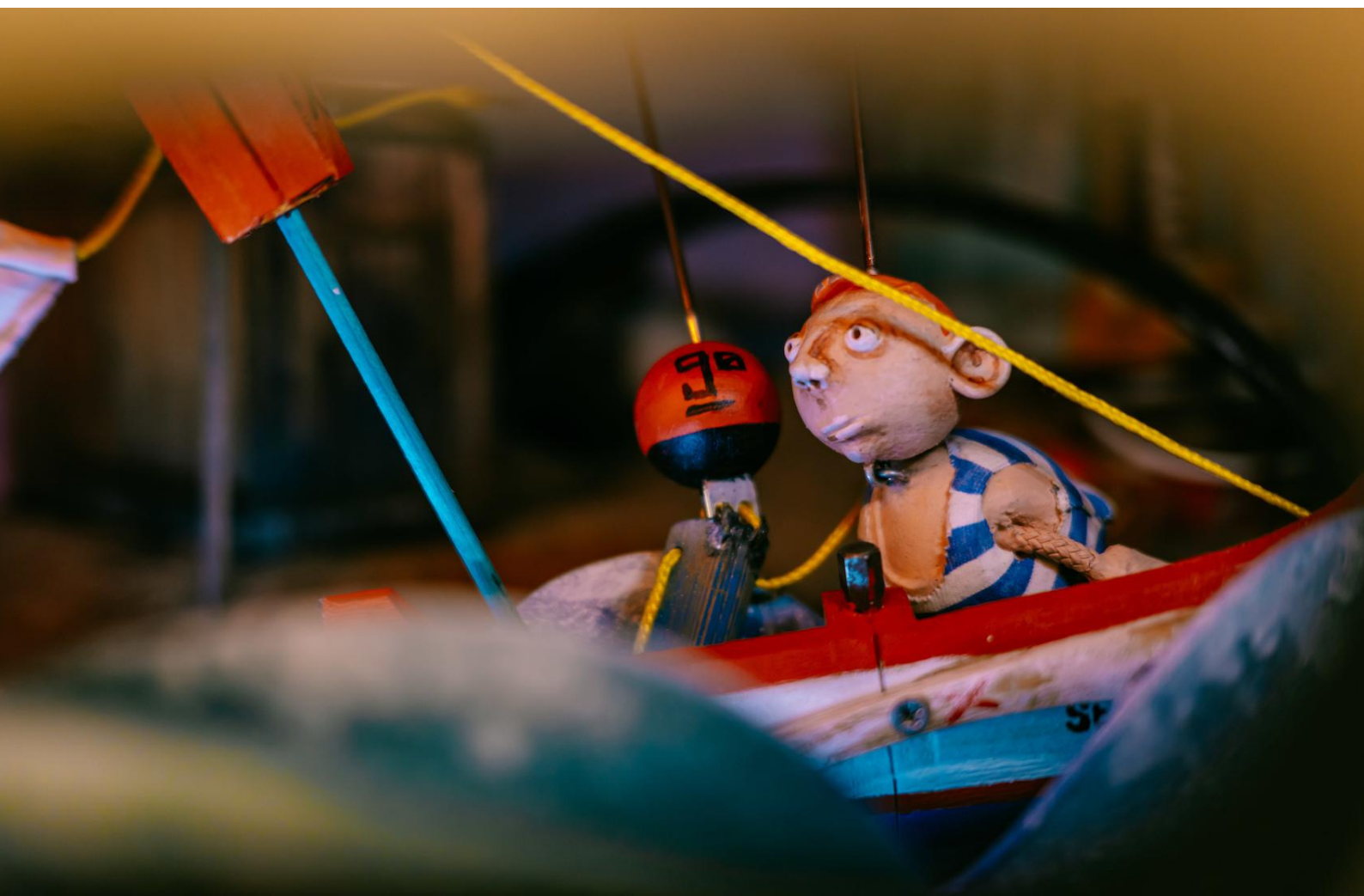


PRESENTATION

Lambe-lambe theatre, or miniature theatre, is a language of animated forms that occupies a reduced scenic space: short theatrical pieces are performed inside a small box. The actor-puppeteer operates from one side of the box while the spectator watches from another, mediated by miniature scenography, soundscapes, lighting, and a carefully crafted scenic atmosphere within. It is, therefore, a theatrical piece generally presented to one spectator at a time, within a condensed timeframe and space.

The Teatro e Marionetas de Mandrágora company presents a journey through the world of miniature puppets to a tiny stage where theatre happens in a deeply individualized way. This small-scale project of ours allows three spectators to enjoy it simultaneously, making it possible for families to watch the performance together.

By gathering these memories, we have prepared another theatrical proposal based on the show “Mãos de Sal” (Hands of Salt). Beyond the main performance, the spectator can also discover a collection of other small boxes and stage machines to observe, explore, or manipulate.

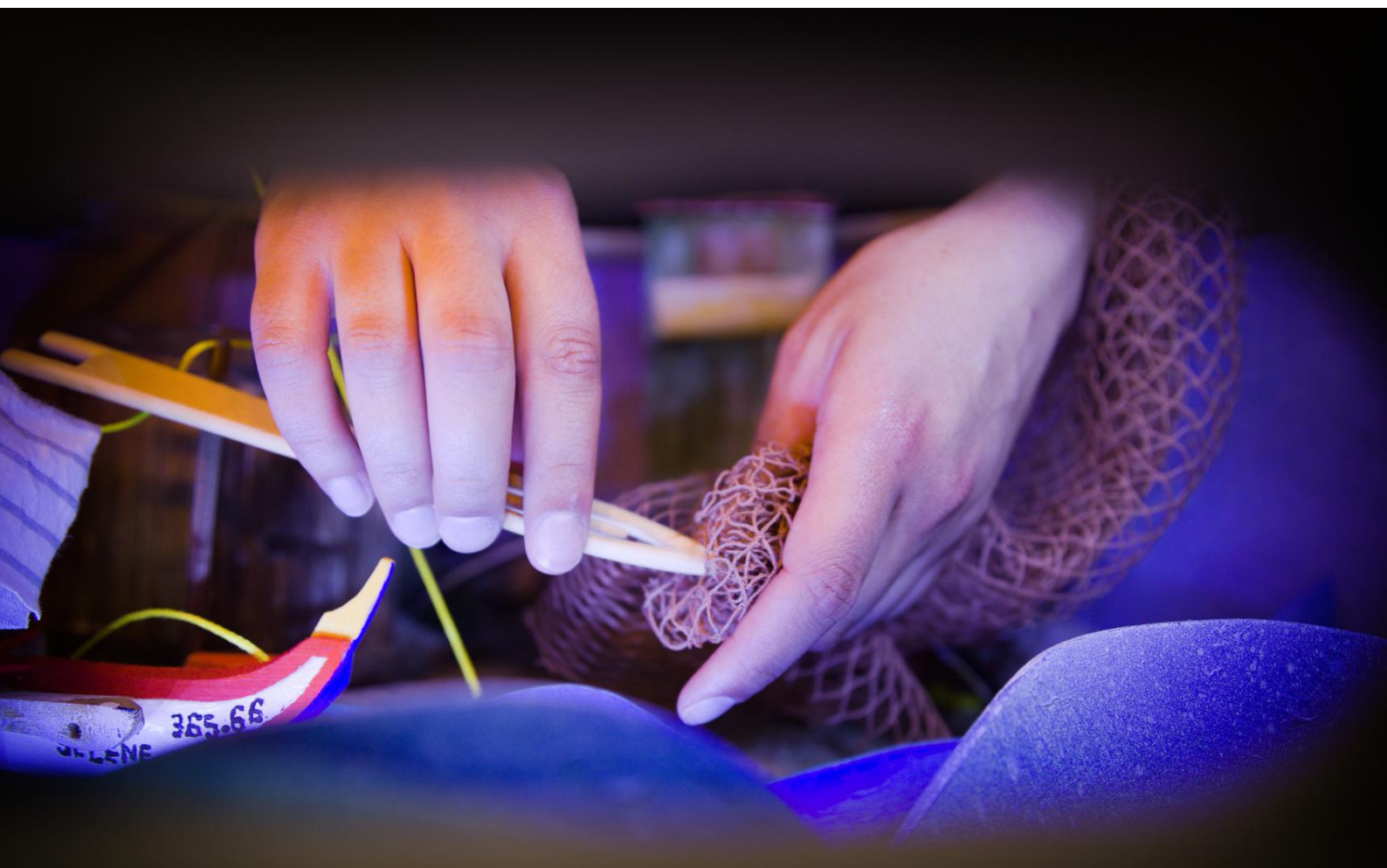


TRAVELLING THEATER

The outdoors, the street, and the open air are as much a way of being as they are a form of artistic dialogue. This is the privileged stage for community life. In a country like Portugal, the occupation of outdoor spaces—our squares, gardens, and beaches—is fundamental. These are places where the sun shines and where families, children, and spectators gather, turning artistic creation into a point of contact, with the sky and the landscape as their backdrop.

Since time immemorial, whether through small or large-scale works, historical contexts, or vibrant festivals, our territory has offered magnificent natural and urban spaces. We populate these settings with countless proposals born from our particular artistic way of being. Whether through new creations, itinerant performances, or the presentation of our beloved Teatro Dom Roberto, we believe that the street and the open air are inseparable from our journey.

The street is not simple; it contends with atmospheric unpredictability, the inconstancy of space, and shifting social dynamics. Yet, it is immediately embraced by the local population—the people who transform a fleeting performance into a lasting memory. We deeply value the outdoors and feel that it remains the ideal place to make art happen.

TEAM CURRICULUM

enVide neFelibata

Monsenhor enVide neFelibata has specialized training in puppet theater, ceramics, engraving, and computer technologies.

Has been involved in puppet theater since 1998 and is one of the founders of the Teatro e Marionetas de Mandrágora company, which has been active since 2002. Is also one of the directors and teachers at Escola da Marioneta (Puppetry School) and co-organizer of “Ei! Marionetas - Gondomar International Puppetry Festival”. Is responsible for the visual direction of this structure, creating puppets, set designs and props. Teaches puppet-making courses for adults and industry professionals, and collaborates with other puppet theater companies and institutions. The work of the professional puppet company he belongs to has already been presented at over 500 national and international festivals and gatherings in the form of shows, animations, performances, workshops, training actions, exhibitions, and art installations to an audience of over one million spectators.

As a visual artist, he devotes himself to the constant desacralization of art, to collaborate with other artists and to joint creations. Researches, develops, and publishes techniques and materials of art expression applied to puppetry art. Has recently participated, organized, and curated exhibitions of mailart and artbypmail in galleries, museums, libraries, and unconventional spaces.

Clara Ribeiro

Clara Ribeiro has continuously explored the combination of manipulation and interpretation techniques with puppetry, combining them with her own contemporary vision, enhancing the relationship between the actor and the puppet so that the contact between these different languages works to create a poetic universe where the search for cultural identity is always present.

Graduated in Acting from ACE - Academia Contemporânea do Espetáculo (Contemporary Performing Arts Academy).

Completed the Professional Course in Animated Theater.

Degree in Heritage Management from the Porto School of Education.

Founder and artistic director of the Mandrágora Theater and Puppetry Company since 2002.

Programmer for the Ponto Pequeno Festival in 2004 and 2005.

Programmer for Ei! Marionetas - International Puppet Festival in Gondomar since 2015.

She has directed, staged, produced, and performed in more than 47 productions by the Teatro e Marionetas de Mandrágora theater company.

He directed the plays “O Gato Preto e a Gaivota Cor-de-Prata” (The Black Cat and the Silver Seagull), “Farsa do Mestre Pedro Pereira” (The Farce of Master Pedro Pereira), “Entre Lugares” (Between Places), “Benilde Bzzzoira,” “Venturas do Nosso Reino” (Adventures of Our Kingdom), “F.U.N.I.L.,” “Mãos de Sal” (Hands of Salt), “desVenturas do Reino” (Misadventures of the Kingdom), “What Are Hands For,” “The Triumph of the Strong,” “The Story of a Cat and a Mouse Who Became Friends,” “A Brief History of Portugal,” “QUEIXA-TE,” “Aurora,” “Madrugada Três-sonhos,” “A menina que pintava pássaros,” “Depois da Chuva,” among others. For the Krisálida company, he was the artistic director and staged the show PLASTIKUS.

Between 2002 and 2024, he also staged 15 educational projects for museums and cultural institutions and 15 community theater projects. He also directs several community projects and collaborates with the Projet'arte Program within the scope of PARTIS.

He received the Revelation Award at the Découver, Images et Marionnette Festival in Tourné, Belgium, in 2001. He has presented his projects at national and international festivals in Spain, France, Belgium, Slovakia, Norway, Bulgaria, and the USA.

Hélder Duarte

Graduated in Artistic Production from the Higher School of Education of Bragança (2006), he subsequently complemented his studies and gained professional experience in various areas of the performing arts.

Mentor, founder, and producer of artistic projects such as Mozarabes and Azrak (medieval Arabic music groups), Neiva (medieval music group), as well as production and production assistance in arts education projects and production support at arts festivals. Active member in the programming, budgeting, planning, and implementation of cultural and artistic activities at the Lamas Movediças Cultural, Recreational, and Sports Association.

Production assistant on the arts education project “Germinar”, an arts education project run by the Santa Maria da Feira Department of Education, from 2017 to 2019.

Production support at the Imaginarius Festival - International Street Theater Festival of Santa Maria da Feira, from 2017 to 2020.

Professional internship in production at the Teatro Vivart theater company - production support for activities, group management, and artistic activities, from 2008 to 2009.

Producer at the Teatro e Marionetas de Mandrágora theater company since 2021.
